Individuals 18 and older with functional, physical, social or cognitive impairments, such as Alzheimer's disease, dementia, Parkinson's disease, stroke or brain injury, enjoy a variety of activities and access to social and health services.

For families and caregivers, the program provides support so they may pursue careers or other interests.

The Adult Daily Living Center, located at the Masonic Village at Elizabethtown, is dually certified and licensed by the PA State Department of Aging and Department of Public Welfare.

## MORE THAN A CENTURY OF SERVICE

The first resident moved to the Masonic Village in 1910. Since then, our Mission of Love has grown to include continuing care retirement services, children's services and community outreach services.

The Adult Daily Living Center opened in August 1995. In November 1996, renovations to the Masonic Health Care Center provided a new home for the center. The location offers a home-like atmosphere, ample space for activities and direct access to a range of medical clinics and services in the same building to further improve participants' quality of life.
