Friendly and experienced staff believe each resident deserves dignity and respect. We embrace a holistic approach to providing exceptional care for the mind, body and spirit within nurturing surroundings. Residents receive personalized services 24 hours a day, seven days a week, including the administration of medications and personal care.

ACTIVITIES & SOCIAL PROGRAMS

Cottage residents can easily access social and recreational opportunities offered on campus. These include a wellness center, indoor and outdoor swimming pools, farm market, model railroad club and non-denominational church services.

Residents also enjoy an interactive, stimulating environment through lifelong learning and leisure programs. Supervised activities focus on the adults' developmental goals to enhance their self-esteem, recognize their talents and explore their creativity. We encourage residents to seek out their own interests and career opportunities within the local community, as they desire.

RATES

The per diem rate includes accommodations, three nutritious meals, social and recreational programs, transportation and assistance with activities of daily living. Funding may be available through the Lancaster County MH/MR office.

MORE THAN A CENTURY OF SERVICE

The first residents moved to the Masonic Village in 1910. Since then, our Mission of Love has grown to include continuing care retirement services, children's services and community outreach services.

When the Bleiler Caring Cottage opened in February 1998, it was the only in-house, respite care facility for adults with developmental disabilities in Lancaster County. To provide continuity for the residents living at the cottage, the Masonic Village transformed the respite care program in 2003, at which time, all of the people living there became permanent residents.
