Masonic Village offers 28 nursing care accommodations and 34 personal care studios. Caring and supportive staff provide for your daily needs and preferences.

Enjoy satisfying meals, planned and prepared under the supervision of our licensed dietitian consultant. Staff pay careful attention to individual dietary requirements to meet nutritional needs.

inpatient and outpatient services add to the care you receive.

ADMISSIONS POLICY

Admissions to the Masonic Village at Warminster are administered by the Committee on Masonic Homes, members of which are elected by the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania. The Committee on Masonic Homes approves or disapproves applications for admission primarily on

the basis of need. Decisions concerning admission, the provision of services and referrals of residents are not based upon the applicant's race, color, religion, disability, ancestry, national origin, familial status, age, sex, limited English proficiency (LEP) or any other protected status.

The Mission of the Masonic Village at Warminster includes serving individuals in Philadelphia County who are day-one Medicaid recipients.

From the PA Turnpike: Take the PA Turnpike to the Willow Grove Exit 343. Follow Route 611 North (Easton Road) to Route 132 East (Street Road); turn right. Turn left onto Norristown Road. The Masonic Village at Warminster is approximately 1/4 of a mile down the road on the left.

From I-95: Take I-95 to Route 132 (Street Road Exit). Follow Route 132 West for approximately 10 miles. Cross Route 263 (Old York Road). At the second traffic light, turn right onto North Norristown Road. The Masonic Village at Warminster is approximately 1/4 of a mile down the road on the left.

From Route 1: Follow Route 1 (Roosevelt Boulevard) to Route 132 (Street Road Exit). Follow Route 132 West for approximately 8 miles. Cross Route 263 (Old York Road). At the second traffic light, turn right onto North Norristown Road. The Masonic Village at Warminster is approximately 1/4 of a mile down the road on the left.

From Route 309: Follow Route 309 South. At the first traffic light past Zoto's Diner, turn left onto County Line Road. Turn left onto Route 611 North (Easton Road). Follow Route 611 for approximately one mile. Turn right onto Route 132 (Street Road). Turn left onto North Norristown Road. The Masonic Village at Warminster is approximately 1/4 of a mile down the road on the left.

From Route 313: From Route 313, turn right onto the Route 611 Bypass. Turn left onto Route 132 (Street Road). Turn left onto North Norristown Road. The Masonic Village at Warminster is approximately 1/4 of a mile down the road on the left.

The Masonic Villages also provide homes and services to seniors in Dallas, Elizabethtown, Lafayette Hill and Sewickley, Pa. All five not-for-profit communities are owned and operated by the Right Worshipful Grand Lodge of Free & Accepted Masons of Pennsylvania.
