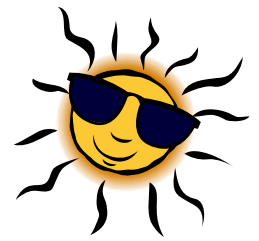




Residential Living Area Calendar August 2010



Pre-registrations for trips begin on Wednesday, July 28th

Trip Registrations: **To Register for off campus -Regular trips –meaning daily scheduled, non-reserved trips and the daily E’Town Shuttle you may sign up at the Reception Desk in the Grand Lodge Hall, phone extension #33205.** A volunteer is on duty weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to take your reservations with your name, phone number and address. When a volunteer is not available a voice mail system will allow you to leave a message. (Voice mail will be checked on weekends and holidays for cancellations only.) We ask that you continue to call at least one working day prior to the trip. Trip availability will be on a first come –first serve basis.*** Off Grounds transportation with the exception of the E’town shuttle may be canceled when there are less then 10 residents signed up to attend. Note: All transportation is dependent upon bus availability and weather conditions.***

Reservations are required in advance for many special trips which are combined between Retirement Living and Residential Living areas. Many have fees which are due upon reservation and others have limited seating. These special reserved trips are listed on a separate trip information list which can be found at the Reception desk and is posted on the main Recreation Bulletin Boards. Reservations will be taken at the Retirement Living Reception Desk or by calling **ext. 14512.** *For payment of trip fees, checks should be made out to Masonic Village with the designated trip listed in the memo area.
